REGULAR BOARD MEETING MINUTES
Reconvened from March 9, 2026, to March 13, 2026***

The Jonesville Town Council reconvened from its Regular Monthly Board Meeting on Monday, March 9, 2026, at 7:00 p.m. to Friday, March 13, 2026, at 3:00 p.m.

Mayor Darnell called the reconvened meeting to order at 3:14 pm.

A motion to reconvene from March 9, 2026, was made by Mayor Pro-Tempore Green, seconded by Council Member M. Tilley, approved by unanimous vote, 5-0.

A motion to approve the Consent Agenda was made by Council Member M. Tiley, seconded by Council Member S. Darnell, approved by unanimous vote, 5-0.

A motion to approve the reconvened agenda for March 9, 2026, was made by Council Member R. Adkins, seconded by Mayor Pro-Tempore Green, approved by unanimous vote, 5-0.

Public Comment Period – No public comment was made.

Presentation – All presentations took place during the original meeting date of Monday, March 9, 2026.

Business – Wendy Thompson, Town Manager, addressed the Council with the following business matters:

1. Agreements for Water Plant Building Improvements include spray foam insulation with Mayberry Spray Foam Insulation, Custom Grading and Concrete to pour and finish a concrete pad for shed, and Mast Steel Structures for the addition of a shed to house the forklift and install ice guards on the roof of main Water Plant building.
 - A motion to approve Agreements with Mast Steel Structures, Custom Grading and Concrete, and Mayberry Spray Foam Insulation made by Council Member T. Wall, seconded by Mayor Pro-Tempore Green, approved by unanimous vote, 5-0.
2. Budget Amendment for water plant building updates include spray foam insulation, ice guards for roof, and addition of shed to house forklift. Fiscal year 2025-2026 budget for Water Fund will be increased by \$20,000 with an appropriation from fund balance.
 - A motion to approve budget amendment for Water Department as presented by Mayor Pro-Tempore Green, seconded by Council Member T. Wall, approved by unanimous vote, 5-0.
3. NC Trail Days Band Agreement for Fair Play's performance at Sgt. Gregory Martin Park on Saturday, June 6th.
 - A motion to approve the band agreement with Fair Play for NC Trail Days was made by Council member S. Darnell, seconded by M. Tilley, approved by unanimous vote, 5-0.
4. Summer Concert Series with the Jonesville TDA funding Eats, Beats, and Summer Seats for all performances to be held at Sgt. Gregory Martin Park from 3 pm-6pm. The Town Manager will execute agreements with performers once they are signed and returned. Agreements include Red River Dawn, Problem Child, Rock Doctor DJ, and Too Much Sylvia.
 - A motion to authorize Town Manager to sign Agreements with bands and DJ for Summer Concert Series was made by Council Member M. Tilley, seconded by Council Member R. Adkins, approved by unanimous vote, 5-0.
5. NC DOR has requested a Property Owner Acknowledgement of Terms for the Voluntary Donation of Property to the North Carolina Department of Transportation for a right of way only. This acknowledgement does not change the vested title and refers to the property where the Interconnect water line between the Town of Jonesville and the Town of Elkin exists. This acknowledgement waives the Town of Jonesville's right to have an appraisal made on the property to determine compensation in exchanged for a Drainage/Utility easement along the property.
 - A motion to approve Acknowledgement of Terms for Voluntary Donation of Property to NC DOT and Drainage/Utility Easement made by Council Member R. Adkins, seconded by Council Member T. Wall, approved by unanimous vote, 5-0.

W. Thompson requested to enter Closed Session pursuant to G.S. 143-318.11(a)(4) for economic development. A motion was made to enter Closed Session by Council Member M. Tilley, seconded by Council Member S. Darnell, approved by unanimous vote, 5-0.

Motion to reenter Open Session was made by Mayor Pro-Tempore Green, seconded by Council Member T. Wall, approved by unanimous vote, 5-0.

A motion to adjourn was made by Council Member S. Darnell, seconded by Council Member R. Adkins, and approved by unanimous vote, 5-0.
